# Get Started - Raytheon Supply Chain Platform (RSCP)

## Step 1. Register

Your organization must receive an invitation from a Raytheon Supply Chain Platform (RSCP) team member to access order management capabilities, which are available by logging in through Exostar's Managed Access Gateway (MAG).

Raytheon Supply Chain Platform will send an e-mail invitation asking you to join their network of suppliers. While completing the Trading Partner Manager (TPM) registration process, you are prompted to register your organization in MAG.

The process differs slightly for companies with an existing MAG account. If you already have an account, you are prompted to purchase your credential before completing your TPM Profile. Please see the [Register](#) page for additional information.

**NOTE:** Raytheon Supply Chain Platform in partnership with BAE Systems, Boeing, and Northrop Grumman have implemented two cybersecurity surveys (Cybersecurity & National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) SP 800-171 Questionnaire) to measure a supplier's ability to manage cybersecurity. When completing the TPM registration profile, you may be asked to complete the Cybersecurity Questionnaire or NIST SP 800-171. ## Step 2. First-Time Login

You will receive an instructional first-time login email to access your MAG account. You are required to complete password setup and set your security questions. The required one-time password is provided by your account's Organization Administrator.

## Step 3. Credentials

Raytheon Supply Chain Platform recommends you obtain a Phone One Time Password (OTP) with Identity Proofing credential in order access RSCP. Please see the [Credentialing](#) page for detailed instructions on the following:

1. Purchase Phone OTP with Identity Proofing via Exostar's web store.
2. Activate credential in MAG user account.
3. Complete identity proofing.
4. Register your phone in MAG user account.

Raytheon also accepts the following multi-factor credentials:

- OTP Hardware with Identity Proofing
- Exostar Mobile ID (powered by Authy™)
- Enterprise Access Gateway (EAG)
- Third-Party Credentials (e.g. DoD CAC, NASA PIV, NGC OneBadge)
- Federated Identity Service (FIS) Medium Level of Assurance (MLOA) Hardware Digital Certificates

## Step 4. Access

Once you complete first-time login and register your mobile phone, you can access the application via Exostar's MAG. To login in with your Phone OTP:

1. After logging in with your user ID and password, the **Phone OTP Authentication** page displays. Select **Phone** and **Delivery Method**.
2. Click **Send**. The OTP Code expires two minutes after clicking **Send**.
3. You receive the OTP code via your selected delivery method. Enter the **OTP Code** in the OTP Code field. Click **Submit**.

4. You are logged in with your Phone OTP credential. Verify you logged in with your Phone OTP credential by confirming the credential strength from your Home dashboard view in your MAG account (upper, right corner).
5. Select **Open Application** next to **Raytheon Supply Chain Platform Procure to Pay**.
